#### Computer Training for Everyone

### Digging of Trenches for Tree Plantation

Shrii Shrii Anandamutiji envisioned Ananda Nagar as a green and vibrant place in his master plan. To advance this vision, afforestation projects are underway all over Ananda Nagar. For the upcoming tree plantation project on 40 acres of land near Asthipahar, a 4-foot by 4-foot trench was dug on 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2024 to protect the saplings from animals. Additionally, in some areas, bamboo fencing will be installed to protect the plants.

### \* The History of Ananda Nagar Post Office



After receiving the land donation in August 1962, the first primary school in Ananda Nagar was established in March 1963. Subsequently, on 1<sup>st</sup> January 1964, a high school was established. At that time, there was no high school within a fifteen-kilometer radius of Ananda Nagar. In order to improve the postal services for the residents of Ananda Nagar, several efforts were made to set up a post office in collaboration with the Indian Postal Department.

In June 1964, permission was granted to establish the "Temporary Baglata Branch Post Office" under the Garjoypur Post Office. Initially, it operated from the then "Press and Book-binding" office. The office's operations were managed by the members of our mission. The first branch postmaster was Ram Prasadji.

On 23<sup>rd</sup> July 1966, Ananda Marga Degree College was established. Following the establishment of the college, the post office was relocated to the college building. Ananta Gope from Barametala village was entrusted with the responsibility of the postmaster. Subsequently, the postmaster's duties were performed by Sunil Adhikari from Punandag, Govinda Mahato, and Kapil Mahato from Shalgram.

In 2002, the post office was moved from the college building to a separate house on Madhukarnika Sarani owned by the mission. Adjacent to it is the Ananda Marga Library, and behind it is the primary school hostel (commonly known as Singbhum Hostel—it was built by the Margiis of the former Singbhum district). On 31<sup>st</sup> March 2003, it was upgraded to a sub-post office, and a sub-postmaster was officially appointed.

The post office experienced attempted looting by miscreants on several occasions. As a result of becoming a sub-post office, the services have significantly increased, and the number of people visiting has also risen. However, the number of staff is much less compared to the demand. Visitors to the post office faced drinking water problems. Dr. Dhiren Chandra Mahato, the local leader of the current ruling party, was informed about this issue and took prompt action to arrange for drinking water.



#### ❖ Annual Akhanda Nám Samíkiirtana in Sidhi-Jelyadi Village



On 7<sup>th</sup> July 2024, in the village of Sidhi-Jelyadih, located in the northern bordering area of Ananda Nagar, the Sidhi-Jelyadih branch of Ananda Marga Pracaraka Samgha organized their annual 12-hour Akhanda "BáBá Nám Kevalam" Nám Samkiirtana. The kiirtan was followed by collective iishvar prańidhán, varńárghyadán, svádhyáya, tattva sabha, and náráyaòa sevá.

### ❖ Distribution of Mango Saplings

On 10<sup>th</sup> July 2024, Ácáryá Sureshananda Avadhuta, the head of the Ananda Marga Farm Department in Banshgad, distributed grafted Himsagar mango saplings to 80 marginal and below-poverty-line families in villages near Banshgarh Farm.

### ❖ Ananda Nagar Girls Shine in the District Taekwondo Competition



On 14<sup>th</sup> July 2024, the 30<sup>th</sup> Purulia District Taekwondo Championship, 2024 took place at the Manbhum Sports Association Indoor Stadium. It was the first time that 10 contestants from the Taekwondo training center, supervised by Ananda Marga Women's College, Ananda Nagar, participated in the competition. All participants were in the sub-junior group, with five winning gold medals and the other five winning silver.

The gold medalists are Renu Mahato, Moumita Soren, Mamata Hembram, Jahnabi Mahato, and Riyabala Karmakar. The silver medalists are Rajshree Mahato, Tanushree Mahato, Arpita Kumar, Tripti Tantubay, and Pushpa Das. All of them are students of Ananda Marga Girls High School. These results are especially noteworthy because it was only a year back on March 11<sup>th</sup> 2023, that Taekwondo training was started at the Ananda Marga Women's College, Umanivas Campus, under the supervision of College Principal Avadhutika Ananda Tapasila Acarya, and the Taekwondo Association of Purulia, and the students have already won medals in competitions.

#### ❖ Purulia District Football League Begins

The Manbhum (Purulia) District Football League 2024-2025 "A" (First) Division football competition was kicked-off with 11 football clubs on 12<sup>th</sup> July 2024. Through a lottery, the 11 clubs are divided into two groups, 'A' and 'B'. Group 'A' consists of five clubs, while Group 'B' consists of six clubs.

On 19<sup>th</sup> July 2024, SSAC Ananda Nagar faced off against Bangiya Sangskriti Goshti. In their second match of the group league, SSAC Ananda Nagar won 5-0.

For SSAC, Achintya Tudu and Amit Mahato scored 2 goals apiece, while Bablu Hansda scored 1 goal.

On 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2024, SSAC Ananda Nagar played against ABBOT SPORTS CLUB. This was the third match for SSAC Ananda Nagar in the "A" group of the league. SSAC-Ananda Nagar won 6-0 with goals from Achintya Tudu (1 goal), Phulchand Hansda (1 goal), Bablu Hansda (1 goal), Dhananjay Hansda (1 goal), and Amit Mahato (2 goals). With this victory, SSAC Ananda Nagar consolidated their position at the top of the group with a total of 17 goals in three matches.



On 31<sup>st</sup> July 2024, the final football match of the Group "A" took place between Purulia Town Club and SSAC Ananda Nagar at the Purulia Manbhum Sports Association ground.
